The topic **Skilling India: Empowering Youth for Tomorrow** was selected to understand the relevance in current scenario and alignment with Make in India Plan of Govt. of India. Skills and Knowledge are the driving forces of economic growth and social development for any country. Countries with higher and better levels of skills adjust more effectively to the challenges and opportunities of world of work. The target groups for skill development comprise of all those in the labour force, including those entering the labour market for the first time (12.8 million annually), those employed in the organized sector (26.0 million) and those working in the unorganized sector (433 million) in 2004-05. The current capacity of the skill development programs is 3.1 million.



India has set a target of skilling 500 million people by 2022. As the proportion of working age group of 15-59

years will be increasing steadily, India has the advantage of demographic dividend. Harnessing the demographic dividend through appropriate skill development efforts would provide an opportunity to achieve inclusion and productivity within the country and also a reduction in the global skill shortages.

There were deliberations by various experts in the conclave, and concluded the following points:

- As skills & knowledge are the driving force for the growth & development of the country, hence a quality teaching strategy to be provided to the students.
- Students should be mentored & motivated to select an industry of their interest in the beginning of the course so that they have full knowledge & skills to serve the best in the selected industry.
- Students should be encouraged for Entrepreneurship.
- Choice Based credit system to be introduced and at least one vocational training to be given to the students.
- There has to be involvement of industry personnel in curriculum design, expert session, providing industrial visits to students, facilitating students for industrial training & projects.
- Colleges may be consulted for solving the problems of industries & may involve teachers for MDPs & projects.
- Case based teaching system to be introduced.
- Students should be empowered to select specialized subjects.
- Regular interactions of industry with academic industries should be encouraged.
- Industrial products & services should have a kind consideration of customers.
- Industry & Institutions may join hands with Govt. of India's NSDC programmes which will help in mission of PM's Skilling India.
- Soft skills of the students should be sharpened which is the need of the hour.
